(i)	The company shall prepare a Plan for transportation of the entire washed coal by rail mode only. (ii)	The proponent shall be establish a railway siding within 3 years for transportation of washed coal from the washery	Yes, we have established own siding.

The linked FBC based Thermal Power Plant shall be existing operational units or commissioned within 2 years of operation of the washery.	Agreed.
